What is the Gospel?

God created the world good. Man's sin and rebellion has broken God's good world and separated man from God. God sent His Son Jesus into the world to die on the cross, in our place, for our sin. After dying for sin, Jesus rose in victory, proving to be the Savior God sent for all who trust in Him. The good news is that forgiveness of sin, eternal life, and fellowship with God comes to man through trusting in Christ's work to save us.

Pattern for Change:

- Identify Idols (example: Comfort, Respect, Approval, Control, Power)
- Confess them to God (*Ps. 51*)
- Believe the gospel and receive grace and forgiveness (*Romans 3:23,24*)
- Walk in newness of life, live in the good of the gospel (*Romans 6:1-4*)

Picture of Change:

- From Non-Christian to Christian (*Romans 5:1*)
- From Self-Centered to God-Centered (*2 Cor. 5:15*)
- From Consumer to Servant (*Phil. 2:3-9*)
- From Member to Missionary (*2 Cor. 5:18,19*)
- From Participant to Leader (*Matt. 28:18-20*)
